Quilt Show Opportunity Quilt

The 2021 Comforts of Home Quilt Show will be here before we know it. The Board has decided that the theme of the Opportunity Quilt will be "Home." The blocks will be various homes—house, apartment building, tent, RV, etc. Also, animal homes should be included—bird house or nest, dog house, bee hive, etc. Blocks can be any size from 6" to 15", and any technique can be used. Use your imaginations to think of a home for something or someone. They would love it if all our members took part. Looking forward to seeing what you come up with.

Fabric has been ordered for the fabrics required in each block. Hopefully, we will be able to hand out packets at the next. Blocks are due by the November when they will be displayed and voted on. Blocks not used in the opportunity quilt will be made into a quilt to be awarded to the winner of a drawing. The entries in the drawing will be those who made a block.

ATTENTION

The Northeast Oklahoma Area Artist Show is cancelled this year because of Covid-19.

HOWEVER, Pryor Area Arts and Humanities Council (PAAHC) is sponsoring an Art Sale for area artists Friday, November 6, 2020 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Saturday, November 7, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the City Hall Gallery and Graham Community Center located at 6 North Adair, Pryor, Oklahoma. There is no entry fee. Pryor Area Arts and Humanities Council will receive twenty percent (20%) of all sales as a fee for exhibiting the art. PAAHC will collect and report all sales tax. PAAHC will provide each artist with their own exhibit table and each artist will be responsible for managing that table and removing unsold art Saturday evening. There is a limited number of tables. Exhibit tables will be assigned on a first come, first served basis so it is important that you contact PAAHC immediately to reserve your table. You may reserve your exhibit table by calling 918-864-7224 or by emailing pryorarts@gmail.com. The deadline for reserving your exhibit table is October 16, 2020. Once your exhibit table is reserved, you will be asked to sign a Letter of Understanding. All artists and shoppers will be required to wear masks and practice social distancing.
