

2021 - April's Block

Seminole Star: cut the following pieces

One 4.5 inch square light and One 4.5 inch square medium for square in a square method that will be demonstrated at the quilt meeting

One 4.3/4 inch square dark or fussy cut for the center of block

Four 3 ½ inch background for the corners

One 9 inch square dark and One 7.5 inch square background for flying geese

OR

Four 4 inch squares of medium dark and four 4 inch background to make 8 half square triangles trimmed to 3 ½ inches



To make 4 flying geese 3.5 by 6.5 inches by the flying geese method Place the 9 inch square of dark and the 7 ½ inch square right sides together. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner and sew ¼ inch on both sides of the line

Cut apart and press to the dark side and draw another diagonal line on the opposite corners. Place right side together and line up the edges to sew on both sides of the drawn line. The two center seams will not match. Clip the center seams so you can press the two blocks in opposite directions. Trim out four 3 ½ in by 6 ½ in flying geese. This method will be shown at the quilt meeting Tuesday April 27th
