Velma gave Sunshine and Shadows and then wished Happy Birthday to those who had July birthdays. Shelley Joslin and Lisa Wilhite did the Fat Quarter Exchange. Linda Shafer handed out door prizes and the Secret Word prize.

Ann reminded us that the Twisted Mystery projects are due in September. Doris Wagon has asked for someone else to handle the donation quilts job. Memorial books were presented to Tes Deringer for Linda Fleming, Mike Jensen for Skippy, Aline Kemp, Bessie Purcell, and Sam Casey. Ann will deliver Skippy's book to Mike.

Quilt Camp will be held July 29-31 at the First Church of God. Members who wish to play the Fat Quarter game will need 9 black and white print fat quarters.

Sassy Stitches meet on Monday at the Extension Center.

August's program will be presented by the ladies from Thread Play Quilt Shop in Wagoner. They will teach us about mitered corners. On Wednesday, they will hold a workshop on the Modern Window Quilt.

Kim said they needed scribes for the Quilt Show; enough ladies volunteered to fill the positions. Angie Cunningham said we needed to make Quilt of Valor blocks for the show. The blocks need to be 12 ½ inches, finishing at 12 inches. Star quilts can be put in the show's special section even if they are not quilted. Entry forms can be printed off, filled out, and need to be in by August 20.

The meeting concluded with Show and Tell of UFO projects and our regular projects. A drawing was held for the UFO prize.

Stitch Groups

Pryor Patchers Quilt Guild currently offers a stitch group and a Dear Jane group that meet on a regular basis. You are invited to participate in any or all of the groups. This is a great way to get better acquainted with others who share your quilting interest.

"Sassie Stitches" Meets every Monday in the Event Center from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm (with a lunch seam ripper break included). We will work on our own projects most of the time; however, there might be an occasion to do group projects. Everyone is welcome.

"Dear Jane Group" meets at Mid American Grill at 6:00pm on the first Tuesday of every month. Everyone buys her own meal. Dear Jane blocks are 4 1/2" blocks that vary from easy to advanced skill levels. You may use your favorite fabrics. There is a Dear Jane quilt book that shows the many types of blocks that can be made using piecing, applique, or a mixture of the techniques. Fat Quarter Drawing

Members may bring 1 or 2 fat quarters to be placed in a basket. They then write their names on a list along with the number of FQs they brought. Shelley Joslin will draw a number and the person whose name is by that number on the list will choose the FQs she wants, limited to no more than two. Themes for the year are:

August – Yellow or tone on tone

September – Gray or fall prints

October – White or checks

November – Brown or holiday prints
